JOINING OUR PARISH

We welcome all who seek a spiritual home in our Catholic community. Introduce yourself to the pastor and he will help you join our parish.

If you are not baptized, or are baptized in another Christian tradition and seek full communion with the Catholic Church, consider the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults process. It begins with inquiry sessions in which you can ask questions and discuss issues with other seekers. The process continues with opportunities for learning and spiritual transformation. The RCIA also serves baptized Catholics who did not have the opportunity to receive Holy Communion and Confirmation. The Director of Religious Education will help you start.

BAPTISM

If you are parents seeking baptism for your child, please introduce yourself to the pastor after Mass. He wishes to meet you in person before making an appointment for baptism preparation.

MARRIAGE

Our pastor invites engaged couples to make an appointment with him at least six months prior to marriage, before setting a wedding date. Couples are welcome to call as soon as you decide to marry or even while you are still considering whether to go forward toward marriage.

MISSION COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND

Next weekend Fr. Dennis Cleary, a Maryknoll Missionary will speak at the Masses and give our parishioners an opportunity to support the vital work of bringing Christ's name and message to all people.

Upon ordination in 1977, Father Cleary was assigned to Venezuela, where he spent 17 years serving as Assistant Regional Superior until 1989, when he was elected Regional Superior for the Venezuela Region. He returned to the United States in 1993 to help open a new Maryknoll development House in Jacksonville, Florida.

Father Cleary served as the U.S. Regional superior of the Maryknoll Fathers and Brothers serving in the United States from 2000-2004. In 2005 he was assigned to China where he taught English at Northeastern University in Shenyang. Fr. Cleary has also served as the director of the Mission Education and Vocation Dept. at Maryknoll, NY and has taught English at the Korean Catholic Foreign Mission Society Seminary. Most recently Fr. Cleary has been the Director of the China Teachers Program. Currently he is a member of the Maryknoll Senior Missioners Community.

While at the parish Fr. Cleary will be happy to talk with any parishioners who are interested in doing overseas mission work as a Maryknoll Priest Sister, Brother or lay Missioner. Next weekend we will have a second collection at all Masses. Please be as generous as you are able.
